Re: Animal Control Within Pagosa Lakes

Dear Owners:

As you may be aware, the Association has recently contracted with Archuleta County to provide additional enforcement of the County's Animal Control Resolution within the Pagosa Lakes community. The County Sheriff has hired a full-time employee whose primary responsibility is full-time animal control within only our community.

A copy of the County's resolution, Resolution 2002-31, regarding animal control follows this letter for your reference. Any complaints regarding dogs running at large, excessive barking, and vicious dogs should be reported directly to the Sheriff's office at 970-264-2131, effective February 1, 2003. The Sheriff will dispatch its animal control officer to respond to the complaint.

As a result of this Agreement, the Board of Directors will be revising the Association's existing rules with regard to animal control. Although the Association will no longer require licensing of dogs, as a service to those owners desiring their dog to wear a license, the Association will issue tags upon proof of the appropriate vaccinations, at no charge to the owner. Please be aware that Archuleta County does have vaccination requirements that must be met.
